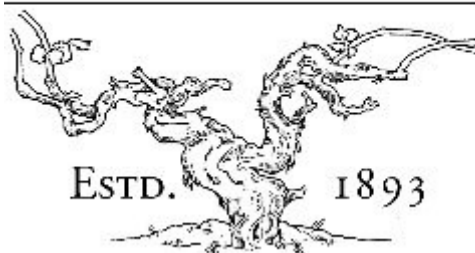

Around mid September 2007 we began our preseason training looking forward to the coming season. We again decided to field 4 sides with the A5's becoming the A3's. At times throughout the year we could have fielded five sides and on other weekends it was a battle to field the four, but to everybody's credit, we never forfeited a match.

Thank you to all senior and junior players who committed to the club this year. Whatever way you look at it we have to find 44 players each Saturday and generally speaking, selection this year was a breeze.

Well done and thank you to Darren Graetz (A2), Kym Farley and Steve Lewis (A3) and Matt Spackman (A4) for captaining and caring about your sides each week. Unfortunately the A1 and A3's missed out on finals action this year but I am excited by the young talent that we had in those two sides and I am looking forward to these players developing next year.

The Semi Final again proved to be a too big of hurdle for the A2's but I am proud of the year they had, and had we had made another 60 or 70 runs in that Semi, we may have found ourselves in the Grand Final. Gawler Central and Lyndoch didn't move from first and second spots all year so credit must be given to them, even if we do think they smell a bit.

It gives players a chance to bat for longer periods of time and those that bat in the lower order more of an opportunity to improve their game. I also see the A3's as a great grade for any U/16's coming into senior cricket to learn their craft. Therefore the 3's this year was a young side and I am hopeful some of these younger players will play higher grades next year.

Another consistent year for the A4's and almost back to back grand final appearances. It's fair to say Gawler Central were the best side all year but whichever way you look at it, the events which took place after that Semi Final were a disgrace. However it was out of our control and we definitely deserved our place in the A4 semi final rather than the A5's. To win 11 out of our 19 games was a great effort considering a number of last year's premiership side moved up to higher grades.
