A2's Captain's Report

Well another season has gone by and we didn't put the Tanunda name on the A2 trophy. It was a pleasure to have a consistent side all year. With an average age in the mid thirties most of us are aware premierships opportunities don't come around very often and I feel everyone gave it a real crack this year, only to be bundled out again in the semi final. The only sides to finish above us were other club's A grade sides which shows we are doing most things right to get into the four.

Finishing fourth is probably a fair indication of our season. We were not able to beat any of the teams who finished above us, but beat teams below us to maintain fourth spot for most of the year. We finished with six wins, five losses and a drawn heat rule. The A2 comp was changed back to sixty five overs; which shortens the game and decreases the chance of getting outright points. I hope this is changed back in the future as A2 cricket should be played under the same rules as A1.

Our bowling and fielding this season was very good, restricting most teams to under 150 runs. Batting was always our problem with only two batsmen making over two hundred runs for the season. We were never able to set big totals, but our bowlers were able to dismiss sides and we won enough games to keep our fourth spot.

There were some good individual efforts this year with Tony Swan making 100 vs Nuriootpa at Tanunda being the stand out batting performance. Most other batters got good starts but couldn't turn fifty's into hundreds- well done Tony. The bowling was shared by openers Pete Mernagh and Sam Cox with Sam getting two five wicket hauls this season the best being 5 for 21 vs Light Pass. The balance of the bowling was done by Paul Healy, Luke Samain and Jamie Roehr, who also got one five for vs Greenock 5 for 33.

I hope everyone has enjoyed the year as much as I have. We all had a lot of fun, sooner or later we'll get a bit of luck on our side and we'll get past that semi final and who knows what might happen. To everyone who played in the A2s this year thank you for your efforts and I hope to see you all next season.
