## A5's Captain's Report

The first half of the season started well with a second round win over Lights Pass, Tanunda 6/288 (S Dunn 88, T Mifflin 68) Lights Pass 10/30 (A Radzevicius 4/3 and B Lockett 3/4). Two forfeits in the first 4 rounds was not good, but the 5's came up against Truro at Faith for a win Tanunda 10/128, after recovering from 8/80 at drinks, R Hentschke 26\*, D Eggleton 16, with Truro 10/ 91 (K Graetz 3/17, D Eggleton 3/41)

Another missed game V Greenock went past then we played Morgan at Tanunda. The final score was Tanunda 10/114 (J Marshall 35, B Smart 22) vs Morgan 4/118 (C Collins 2/24).

Next against Lights pass saw a win, Lights Pass 10/130 (C Shaw 5/13) and Tanunda 7/139 (J Hartigan 56).

A journey to Eudunda followed with ERCC 10/155, outstanding bowling spell by K Underwood finishing with 6/2 and T Eggleton 2/24, however a loss in the end with Tanunda being bowled out for 97 (B Smart 34, H Smart 19).

Truro at Truro followed for a strong game Tanunda 5/241 (B Smart 60, D Eggleton 49\*, H Smart 45, J Thompson 35). Bob and Hugh Smart father and son put on 105 opening run stand, J Thompson and D Eggleton put on 70 in the last 5 overs, finishing off the innings with some lusty hitting, defeating a solid Truro 9/210 (B Smart 3/28, D Eggleton 2/34). Christmas then followed.

The Second half of the season began with extended heat spells and no cricket. When the season returned Captain Bob was training for an Ironman triathlon in Melbourne so we missed out on his captaincy and batting prowess.

## U12 Coaches Report

We started the season with one under 12 team and 13 players. Some of these guys were first year players, while others were seasoned cricketers returning for their second and third year of under 12 cricket. A number of new players donned the whites for the Tanunda Cricket club for the very first time, great to see so many new faces in all junior grades of cricket.

We started the season at Stockwell against Light Pass and it's fair to say all the boys were extremely excited about our first game. Not knowing what to expect I was pleasantly surprised with the cricketing potential our side showed, making 3 for 81 and in reply the opposition 7 for 39, a great start to the season. From there, the boys continued to improve week by week.

Over the course of the season the boys learnt the value of keeping their wicket, the value of running a quick single and not just hitting the boundaries, the value of a batting partnership and positive calling and running between wickets. A few highlights of our season with the willow were 5/96 against Eudunda Roberstown and 9/105 against Sandy Creek Gold. Players learnt the value of backing up in the field and encouraging each throughout our bowling innings. 5 games were cancelled due to heat and believe it or not 1 game to rain. Disappointing for the boys considering the improvements they had made throughout the year.
