Coaches Report

I am very much a glass half full man in Cricket and Life. Coaching the Tanunda Cricket Club this season gave me an insight into regional cricket, town life and the Club.

The clubs three senior teams could perhaps be labeled with a glass half full sticker at the end of the season. I will let the better qualified captain's comment on the season's outcomes. We need to improve most parts of our games to get the glass way past half full.

Cricket is a game that has built a great culture of stories, literature and history around it. Tanunda Cricket Club took a while for me to truly discover. As a coach at the start of the season I could see that I would have to take a long term approach to helping the players reach their full potential, no matter what their age or God given ability. Listening to the stories on Thursday night coming from present and past players I gleaned the real state of play for the club overall.

Individual players who attended practice regularly have developed their techniques and as such gained greater success with bat and ball. Introducing biomechanics, sport science, sport psychology, and new strategies in the game can only develop into outcomes if players practice with purpose and practice regularly.

We had a struggle at times to field teams due to various changes in players social and work lives. There is no doubt that we need to introduce a few changes next season to help build a stronger club culture which will bring us results we are prouder of.

At the last TCC Committee meeting, I outlined a few big picture ideas to work on next season when we get back onto the home turf pitch.

They are:

1. Thursday night with the coach will be compulsory with practice starting at 5.30pm for the keen students of the game who want individual sessions including throw downs. 6.30 pm is the latest starting time for players during day light saving time. If players can't make training for a good reason, they should SMS their captain.
At 8 pm after a refreshing ale and sausage teams will be announced. On a fortnightly basis a colourful past player will be invited along to tell a few yarns of past seasons.
I plan to give a short pep talk each evening after training. This rich game is played very much between the ears once you have a sound and simple technique.
Let's dream of having 30 to 40 blokes around for half an hour of cricket tall stories after Thursday's training session from 8 to 8.30pm
2. In order to bring the full TCC community together, I suggest we plan an extended family 20/20 Sunday game or two for early in the season. This could take the form of a father and son/past player/sponsors day. I would like to invite a few past players from the SA side who I know have played on the ground and enjoy a Barossa red or two to be part this day and of the new TCC season. The ongoing development of strong relations with our sponsors and past players is important to the sustainment of TCC great culture and history.
3. In preseason, I would like to run a master class for all junior coaches and dads and keen payers to get a consistent coaching biomechanics and skill acquisition message across the whole club.
4. The club has been dreaming about having its own pavilion overlooking the main oval for a decade. Let's action this dream into reality. Let's do the planning, fund raising, lobbying and work to bring this to life soon. With the council and its consultants planning big changes for the town over the next few years, now

I look forward to helping the club enjoy a ripping season on and off the field next season. Enjoy the winter and the ashes in England over the break. Let's dream again of the successes achieved by the TCC teams of the late 1940's and early 1950's and more recently follow the example set by the mid 1990's and 2002 to 2004 teams .
