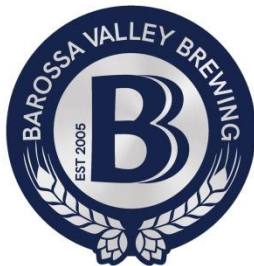

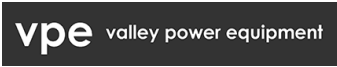

A3 Captain's Report
