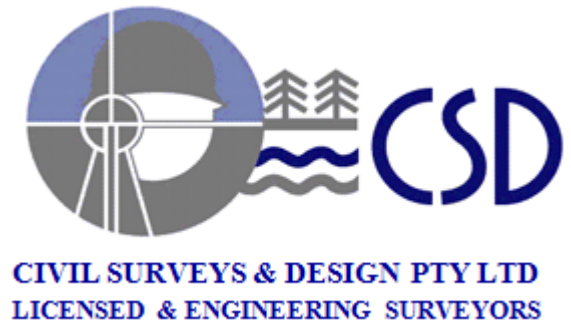

# A1 Captain's Report

# A4 Captain's Report

We played Greenock in the semi-final, and we had a great team effort to win. We had Dylan "Dilshan" Abinett put up his hand for a man of the match performance in this game, his gritty 55 helped guide us to a respectable total of 7/146. We also had solid contributions from Pete Mernagh 29 and Toby Mifflin 21\*. Dilshan then took the ball and bowled us into a grand final with figures of 5/14 off his 7 overs. Steve Lewis also had a handy contribution with 2/14. We held Greenock to 77.

We then played Willaston in the Grand Final, winning the toss and deciding to have a bat. Things didn't go so well and at 4/20 we were in trouble. Wade Dahlitz put his hand up in his man of the match performance scoring 43 off 44 balls, Dilshan provided good support with 23 runs and Timmy Smith also chipped in with 35\* to guide us to a solid 8/161.

We then took the field, a solid bowling performance held Willaston to 2/57 at drinks. The last 20 overs were an even tussle between the sides and the game was extremely tight. We managed to have 17 runs in the bank with 2 overs to go. Tim Smith completed his only over of the day with only conceding 5 runs, leaving Wade with 12 runs to play with for his final over. He got a wicket on his first ball, then next ball went to Liam Boschen, and he's unfortunately thrown the ball over the boundary for a 6! The next 3 balls went for 2 runs leaving Willaston needing 3 off the last ball for a win, 2 for a draw which would also be a win for them being higher on the ladder than us, or 1 or less would see us win. They hit the ball to Dilshan, he's thrown it back over the top of the stumps to our man of the match Wade who has taken the bails off for us to win the grand final by a foot. Wade took 3/37 and Steve Lewis chipped in with 2/27.

I have to say some thankyou's for the year, I would firstly like to thank all the players that helped us get to the finals, the 5s guys that step up to help out and I would like to also thank Harry, Oscar, Ben S, Ben M, Noah and Sam Rosty, you guys are the future of this club and our senior sides are grateful that you guys stand up every week to make sure us old blokes
